2. MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY 11TH MAY, 2016

The Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 11th May 2016, having been circulated, were taken as read, **AGREED** and signed by the Chairman.

3. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Paul Hayter from Stalham and Smallburgh CFR gave a presentation. He reported that all the volunteers are DBS checked and so far this month he has volunteered 160 hours. They cover the area from Mundesley, Stalham and Sea Palling. All their equipment has to be paid for by the volunteers including the uniforms. The equipment is aging and needs replacing. A grant request will be considered under the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council which follows this meeting.

A member of the public enquired why coaches were not allowed to park on the North Norfolk District Council car park. She had a very dangerous experience recently when two big coaches and a bus were parked in Clink Road and two tractors coming the other way had to mount the verge to pass. District Councillor Price will look into this matter and report to the next Parish Council meeting.

A member of the public enquired whether there were any plans to update the play equipment in the playground. It was reported that the playground is the responsibility of the Sea Palling with Waxham Community Trust and the Secretary will liaise with the member of public on this matter. District Councillor Price said that the North Norfolk District Council Big Society Fund is available and funds play equipment. It was also reported that the Norfolk Community Foundation is a good source of grant funding information. The Secretary of the Community Trust has liaised with both bodies and has the contact details.
